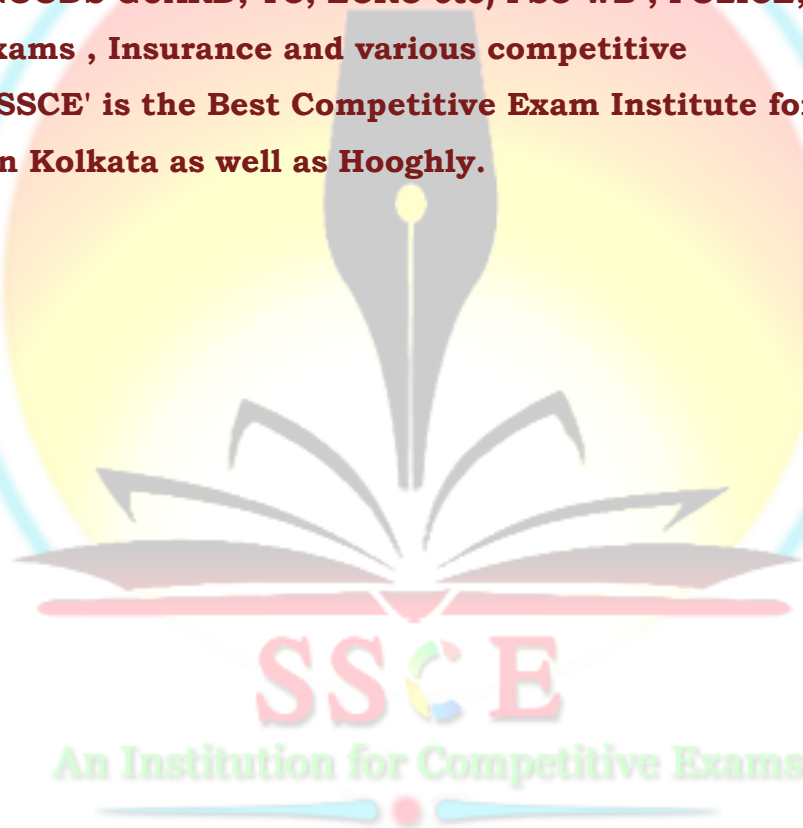

Ans:- **Enhanced in position**

Explanation:- **Part (b) of the sentence is wrong. The correct word that will suit the statement is 'elevated'. Correct application of word enriches the meaning of the sentence**

Ans:- **Who is responsible**

Explanation:-**Part (b) of the sentence is wrong. The correct form of sentence is 'It is I am who should be responsible for the delay'.**

Ans:- **To the evils which newly**

Explanation:- **Part (b) of the sentence is wrong. The preposition of this sentence of is missing in this part . 'Of' is applicable after the word 'evils'**

Synonyms

1)**ACCRUE**:- The word **Accrue(verb)** means: **to increase over a period of time; to allow a sum of money or debts to grow over a period of time ; accumulate**

Hence the word **accrue** and **accumulate** are synonyms

2)**POIGNANT**:- The word **Poignant(Adjective)** means; **having a strong effect on your feeling especially in a way that makes you feel sad , moving ; stinging**

Hence the word **poignant** and **sad** are synonyms

3) **QUERULOUS** The word **Querulous (Adjective)** means; **complaining ; showing that you are annoyed; peevish**

Hence the word **commence** and **conclude** are antonymous
